

Pratiksha Trust Scholarship - Terms, Rules, and Requirements

(Academic Year 2025 - 2026)

1. Eligibility Criteria

- Students who have **passed Plus Two from Kerala** and have obtained **admission to Medicine (MBBS) or Engineering** in the **academic year 2025–2026** are eligible to apply.
- Candidates must have secured **above 80% marks** in the Plus Two examination.
- Candidates must also have achieved a **good score** in the **KEAM / JEE / NEET** entrance examination (for NEET, only the *All-India Rank* should be provided).
- The **annual family income** should be **below Rs. 3,00,000**.
- **Students already receiving any other scholarship will not be eligible** for this scholarship. Applications from such candidates will be **rejected**.

2. Scholarship Amount

- For **Engineering students**: Maximum **Rs. 54,000 per year** for **four years**.
- For **MBBS students**: Maximum **Rs. 60,000 per year** for **4.5 years**.

3. Required Documents

Applicants must upload **clear copies** of the following documents along with the application form:

1. **Passport-size photograph**
2. **College admission receipt**
3. **Plus Two mark sheet**
4. **Entrance exam rank sheet** (NEET: *All-India Rank* should be provided / KEAM / JEE, etc.)
5. **Income certificate**

4. Selection and Award

- Applications will be **reviewed and shortlisted** based on academic merit, financial need, and completeness of the application.

- Shortlisted students will be invited for an **online personal interview** conducted by **Pratiksha Trust**.
- **Not all applicants will receive the scholarship. Only students selected after the personal interview will be awarded the scholarship.**

5. Scholarship Disbursement

- The approved scholarship amount will be **transferred directly to the student's bank account** via **NEFT**.
- The scholarship will be **continued annually** only if the student maintains **satisfactory academic performance**.
- **Students must update and submit the required supporting documents every year** to continue receiving the scholarship. Failure to update documents may result in suspension or cancellation of the scholarship.

6. Termination and Conditions

- The scholarship will be **terminated** if the student:
 - Fails to maintain good academic performance,
 - Fails or discontinues their studies, or
 - Provides false or misleading information in the application.
- **Pratiksha Trust** reserves the **full right to withdraw or cancel** the scholarship at any time if the above conditions are violated.
- The scholarship will be **subject to the continuation of sponsorship** by Pratiksha Trust. In the event of discontinuation of sponsorship, the Trust will not be legally liable or subject to any claims or actions.
